Team Senior created Club Sixty in 2019 to fill a void in Grants Pass, as there was no senior center or place for folks to gather socially, and share in activities.

Club Sixty will not be a traditional senior center anytime soon. We are not staffed for that, nor can Team Senior afford that. We do not get grant money because we are not a non-profit and we do not charge a membership fee.

Team Senior opted to create Club Sixty, and pay for everything, because we know it is a valuable resource for seniors.

Most folks are very understanding and appreciative, but we get the occasional person that wants to know why we can and cannot do a wide variety of things... I hope this letter addresses those questions. Understanding that there is no 'pool of funds' to access, and yet we are able to give this to our community is huge!
